Alameda Corridor-East Project Fact Sheet

ACE Project Accomplishments

Construction

- ✓ Jump Start safety and mobility improvements completed at 39 grade crossings in the Cities of Diamond Bar, El Monte, Industry, Montebello, Pico Rivera, Pomona, Rosemead, San Gabriel, Temple City, Walnut, West Covina and unincorporated Los Angeles County.
- ✓ Seven grade separation projects completed at Nogales Street (Industry/West Covina), Reservoir Street (Pomona), Ramona Boulevard (El Monte), East End Avenue (Pomona), Brea Canyon Road (Diamond Bar/Industry), Sunset Avenue (Industry) and Orange Avenue (Industry).
- ✓ Grade separation projects preparing to start construction in 2012 include the San Gabriel Trench, Baldwin Avenue (El Monte) and Nogales Street (Industry/LA County).
- ✓ Completed construction of four-quadrant gates at five railroad crossings in Pomona.

Funding

- ✓ Total funds committed: \$1.211511 billion (does not include \$358 million in unprogrammed Measure R funding)
- ✓ Total Project Cost Estimate: Safety improvements, first 14 grade separations – \$1.131 billion
Remaining eight grade separations – \$697.5 million (with inflation)

Regional Benefits

- ✓ Employment of 225 contracting companies, with 10% headquartered in San Gabriel Valley.
- ✓ Will result in elimination of horn-blowing at 28 crossings.

Administrative

- ✓ Achieved 18% disadvantaged business enterprise participation.
- ✓ Approved Master Construction and Maintenance Agreements with UPRR.
- ✓ Continuing Caltrans & MTA audits have resulted in only minor findings.
- ✓ Launched comprehensive Project Website: www.theaceproject.org.
- ✓ Toll-free Project Help Line, (888) ACE-1426, operating in three languages.
- ✓ ACE Project video regularly updated and distributed.
- ✓ 25,000 ACE student safety kits distributed to schools near construction sites.
