### REQUEST FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION OF GENERAL CONTRACTORS FOR THE SAN GABRIEL TRENCH GRADE SEPARATION PROJECT CONSTRUCTION BID

To Interested Parties:

Notice is hereby given that the Alameda Corridor-East Construction Authority ("ACE") has determined that all General Contractor ("Contractors") bidders on the forthcoming **San Gabriel Trench Grade Separation Project** ("Project") to be undertaken by ACE must be pre-qualified prior to submitting a bid. It is mandatory that all Contractors who intend to submit a bid, fully complete the pre-qualification application, provide all materials requested herein, and be approved by ACE to be on the final qualified Bidders list. No bid will be accepted from a Contractor that has failed to comply with these requirements. If two or more business entities submit a bid as part of a Joint Venture, or expect to submit a bid as part of a Joint Venture, each entity within the Joint Venture must be separately qualified to bid.

All Pre-Qualification packages submitted via online or hardcopy must be submitted and received by ACE **no later than 5:00 pm (PST) on Monday, December 12, 2011.**

The Pre-Submittal Meeting (**Mandatory for Prime Contractors**) will be held on Monday, November 14, 2011 at 2:00 pm at the City of San Gabriel City Hall Council of Chambers, located at 425 S. Mission Drive, San Gabriel, CA 91776.

#### **PARKING**

**Attendees must park at the San Gabriel Mission Playhouse parking lot located at 320 S. Mission Drive, San Gabriel, CA 91776. Please allow ten (10) minutes to walk to City Hall. Please DO NOT park at the City Hall parking lot.**

The estimated cost of construction for the project is from **\$240,000,000 to \$280,000,000.**

Project Location and Description: The San Gabriel Trench Grade Separation Project (SGT) is located within the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Alhambra subdivision and commences in the city of Alhambra, traverses easterly through the city of San Gabriel and terminates in the city of Rosemead. The project limits begin at approximately mile-post (MP) 489.4 and end at MP 491.6. The grade separations at Ramona Street, Mission Road, Del Mar Avenue, and San Gabriel Boulevard will be accomplished by lowering the railroad track at these street crossings into a 2.2 mile trench and then constructing bridges over the trench at each location. The grade separations will be phased in accordance with the Plans and Specifications. The main rail line would return to grade and join existing conditions just east of Walnut Grove Avenue. New permanent railroad bridge structures will also be constructed at the Alhambra and Rubio Washes.

San Gabriel Trench Grade Separation Project  
Pre-Qualification Application  
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Major components of work consists of relocating and newly constructing various wet and dry utilities which include substantial fiber optic infrastructure installation and coordination with fiber optic owners, construction of a shoofly railroad line, a trench (which requires installation of retaining walls with and without tiebacks and concrete slab), roadway overhead structures, modifications to Alhambra Wash and Rubio Wash, and various public roadway construction. All work associated with this project will be done while maintaining rail operations on the existing main line and the shoofly and within major actively travelled roadways. All work will require multiple phasing and sequencing, various constraints shall be adhered to. A portion of the project will be done adjacent to the historic landmark of the San Gabriel Mission and site specific mitigation monitoring measures are required. All Environmental Impact Report requirements and mitigation measures shall be adhered to.
