**** CONSTRUCTION ALERT ****

VACANT WAREHOUSE/INDUSTRIAL BUILDING ON BALDWIN AVENUE TO BE DEMOLISHED



WHAT/WHERE

Contractors will demolish a vacant warehouse/industrial property at 4251 Baldwin Avenue, north of the railroad crossing (see map above), as part of early construction activities for the Baldwin Avenue Grade Separation Project to be constructed by the Alameda Corridor-East Construction Authority (ACE).

WHAT TO EXPECT

The right lane of southbound Baldwin Avenue near the Union Pacific Railroad tracks and one lane of northbound Baldwin Avenue toward Gidley Street may be impacted as needed to accommodate trucks for the demolition and hauling of materials. Construction equipment will be located onsite for approximately 35 days during the demolition period. Waste service trucks will make approximately 8-12 trips per day during the demolition period to haul away debris and inert materials.

WHEN

The demolition will commence approximately **Tuesday, February 21, 2012** and continue through **Tuesday, March 20, 2012**. Most work will occur between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. on weekdays only. Weekend work will require city approval. Dates are subject to change. Please check the ACE website at www.theaceproject.org or call the ACE Helpline for the most up-to-date information.
