

# **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

### TRAFFIC LANE REDUCTIONS ON MINES AVE, MONTEBELLO BLVD AND MONTEBELLO WAY FOR APPROXIMATELY 8 WEEKS BEGINNING APRIL 4TH



#### WHAT

Contractors will conduct pre-construction activities as part of the initial phase and early construction activities for the Montebello Corridor Grade Separation Project. These activities are planned along Mines Ave., Montebello Way, and Montebello Blvd., (see map above). This work includes:

- Clearing of vegetation and debris
- Removal of existing road elements such as curbs and gutters
- Land grading and concrete installation
- Utility relocation
- Setting up temporary traffic measures

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

For approximately eight (8) weeks, residents and motorists can anticipate:

- Lane Reductions: Traffic lanes on westbound Mines Ave. from Montebello Blvd. to Greenwood Ave., as well as on Montebello Way and Montebello Blvd. between Whittier Blvd. and Olympic Blvd. will be intermittently reduced to one lane in each direction.
- **Parking and Pedestrian Access:** There may be restrictions on street parking and pedestrian walkways near the construction zone.
- **Construction Activities:** Expect the presence of machinery and equipment, which can lead to potential noise, dust, and vibration. These will be closely monitored to ensure compliance with applicable limits.
- Driveway Access: Access to both commercial and residential driveways will be maintained throughout the project.
- **Safety First:** We encourage pedestrians and motorists to exercise caution and follow all posted construction signs, when navigating through or near the construction area for the safety of the public and the construction crew.

#### WHEN

Start Date: Thursday, April 4, 2024

**Duration:** 8 weeks (subject to change based on project need or weather conditions)

**Working Hours:** Weekdays between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. Any necessary nighttime work will be scheduled between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. to reduce overall traffic impact.
