



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

MAY 8: VAIL AVENUE SOUTHBOUND LANE CLOSURE FOR EDISON UTILITY WORK



WHAT

Southern California Edison contractors will continue the remaining electrical utility line activities (cutover) necessary for the At-Grade Safety Improvements at the Vail Avenue railroad crossing as part of the Montebello Corridor Grade Separation Project.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Residents, businesses and motorists can anticipate:

- **Closures and Alternate Routes:** Planned full closure of the southbound lane of Vail Avenue between W. Mines Avenue and Ferguson Drive. Motorists are encouraged to follow and use posted alternate routes during this construction work (see map above).
- **Parking and Pedestrian Access:** There will be restrictions on street parking and pedestrian access near the construction zone.
- **Construction Activities:** Expect the presence of machinery and equipment, which can lead to potential noise, dust, and vibration.
- **Driveway Access:** Access to both commercial and residential driveways will be maintained.
- **Safety First:** We encourage pedestrians and motorists to exercise caution and follow all posted construction signs when navigating through or near the construction area for the safety of the public and the construction crew.

The closure is planned for **Friday, May 8, 2026** between 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
