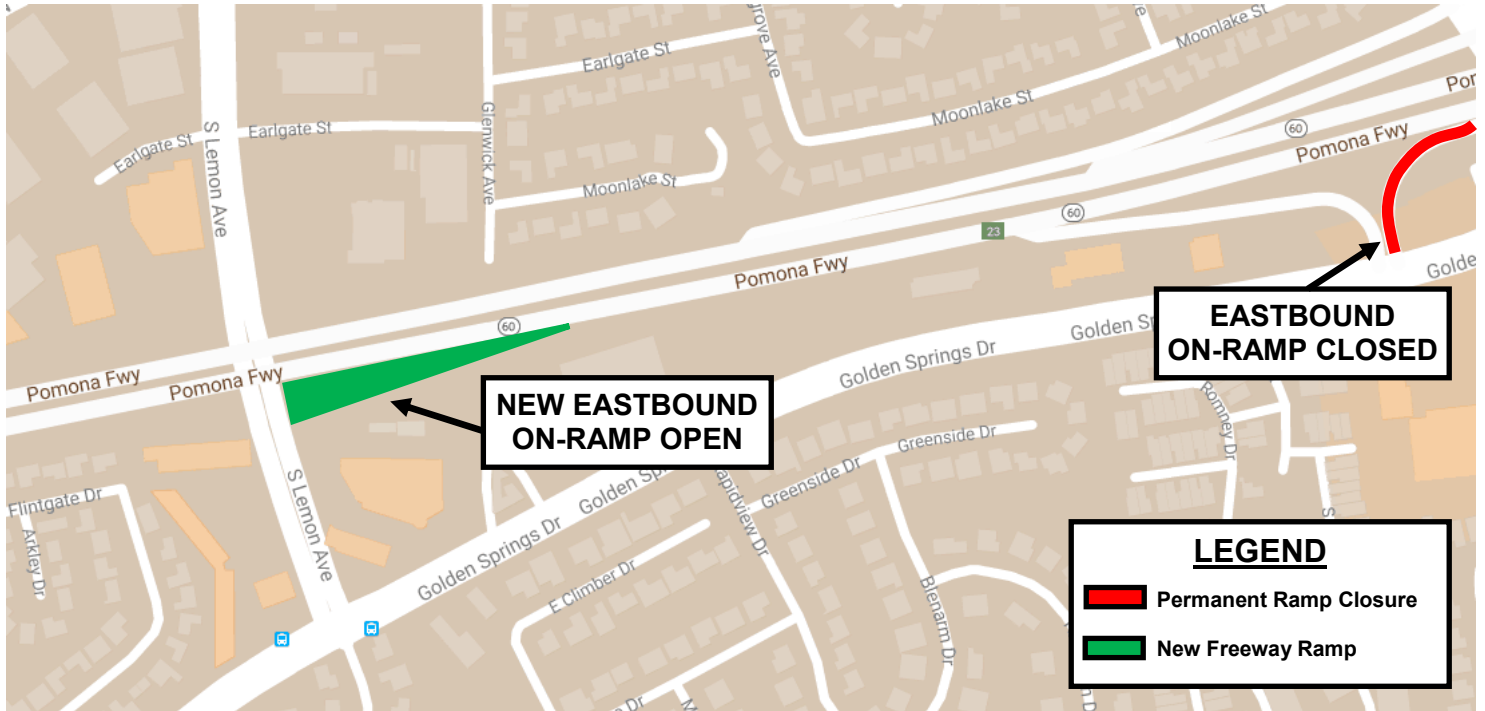




****COMMUTER ALERT****

NEW STATE ROUTE 60 EASTBOUND ON-RAMP AT LEMON AVE. OPENS ON OCTOBER 16; EASTBOUND ON-RAMP AT BREA CANYON RD. TO PERMANENTLY CLOSE



WHAT

As part of the State Route 60/Lemon Avenue Interchange Project, the Alameda Corridor-East Project (ACE), on behalf of the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and in conjunction with the Cities of Diamond Bar and Industry, the newly constructed Pomona Freeway (SR-60) eastbound on-ramp at Lemon Avenue will open to traffic. Simultaneously, the eastbound SR-60 on-ramp at Brea Canyon Road will be permanently closed. The new on- and off-ramps at Lemon Avenue were built to improve traffic flow, reduce traffic weaving and improve safety at the confluence of SR 57-60, the most congested freeway segment in the nation.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists will have access to the newly constructed Lemon Avenue eastbound on-ramp to SR-60. The eastbound SR-60 on-ramp at Brea Canyon Road will be permanently closed.

WHEN

The Lemon Avenue on-ramp opening and the permanent eastbound Brea Canyon Road on-ramp closure will occur at approximately **9 a.m. on Tuesday, October 16, 2018.**
